2019 Amateur Wine Competition

This will be Newport Oregon's 42nd Annual **Seafood & Wine Festival**. Along with the fun of the Festival comes the competition of amateur wines.

Rules for Entry:

- A complete registration form must be submitted with each wine entry.
- Each entry will consist of: one (1) completed registration form, one (1) bottle (750ml) of selected wine to compete, and \$10.00. Please make payment to the Greater Newport Chamber of Commerce. If you are entering more than one wine, you do NOT need to enclose separate payment for each. (One check will suffice).
- The **Variety and Category** should be clearly marked on the front of the bottle as well as on your application.
- Your name should be clearly labeled on the bottom or side of the bottle. Bottles without proper identification will be disqualified. Please feel free to include a specialty label if you have one since the bottle will be displayed at the festival.
- Blind judging will be conducted by a panel of judges. Gold, Silver, and Bronze will be awarded along with one "Best of Show." Wines that are awarded any of the previously listed classifications will be mailed a certificate.
- Display bottles can be picked up at 3:30 pm on Sunday February 24, 2019.
- Results of the competition will be mailed to all participants by March 1st.
- **Please do not enter wines that have been previously judged in this competition.**
- Remember each entry must have a complete registration form. All entries must be received by the Greater Newport Chamber of Commerce no later than **January 25, 2019**, and to a Drop Site NO LATER THAN **JANUARY 18, 2019**.
